"The AIDS Drug Assistance Program has already experienced a 'double whammy' in 2013, as Sequestration is threatening to cut funding in addition to the lost funding under the recently approved FY13 Continuing Resolution passed by Congress and signed in law by President Obama," said **Brandon M. Macsata**, CEO of the ADAP Advocacy Association. "Whereas efforts are underway to restore the funding, patient concerns over lack of access needs to remain a focal part of the community's message to policy-makers. Our annual conference provides that very opportunity for them."

The conference will provide the platform for follow-up discussions on the implementation of the Affordable Care Act, as well as an opportunity to assemble ADAP stakeholders to discuss strategies to maintain a robust Ryan White CARE Act. It will also showcase the **3rd Annual ADAP Leadership Awards Dinner on Monday, July 8th at 7:00 pm**.
