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## ADAP Advocacy Association Announces "Intersection Between ACA & ADAP Summit"

(January 23, 2014) – The <u>ADAP Advocacy Association</u>, also known as <u>aaa</u>+, together with the <u>Community Access National Network</u> (CANN) "Hepatitis: Education, Advocacy & Leadership" (HEAL) project, today announced that it is hosting its annual summit on Sunday, April 13th - Tuesday, April 15th, 2014. The summit, themed "Intersection Between ACA & ADAP Summit," will be open to the public, but only invited panelists will be participating on the various roundtables – which will be facilitated by an independent moderator.
