# **Nearly two million** people identify as transgender


(0.6% of total U.S. population), and they are disproportionately affected by HIV.

Whereas the estimated HIV prevalence is only 0.5% among the general population, it is

3.2% among transgender men and 14.1% among transgender women.

According to the CDC Medical Monitoring Project, HIV care continuum outcomes for transgender patients lags behind people overall with HIV:
