Despite hospital revenue growth and hospital CEO pay raises, medical debt is exploding and patients owe 74% of that debt to hospitals...

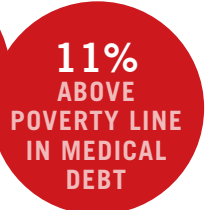
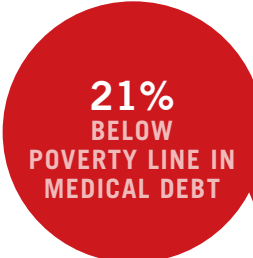


Approximately **14 million people owe over \$1,000** in medical debt and roughly **3 million people owe more than \$10,000.***

Some nonprofit hospitals aggressively pursue patients over their bills.



Americans earning 399% or less of the Federal Poverty Level are **more likely** to hold medical debt than those earning 400% or more.*
